1. Apologies for Absence: None
2. Minutes: Resolved that minutes of the Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 19th March, Annual Parish Meeting on Thursday 19th March & Annual Meeting of the Parish Council on 21st May and the Parish Council Meeting on Thursday 21st May, can be taken as read, approved & signed by the chairman as a correct and true record.
3. Declaration of the Existence & Nature of Interests: None
4. Matters Arising: None
5. Planning Matters: Planning consultation for application for a bridleway near Fremington edge from the British Horse Society
6. Highways:
  - 6.1 Noted that the parish clerk has contacted area 1 Richmond with regards to the overhanging trees at the Dales Beck and a response has been received that the Highways Officer has noted this and added it to his work order
  - 6.2 Noted that the parish clerk has contacted area 1 Richmond with regards to the potholes on the parish roads and the Highway Officer has inspected the area on the 14th or August and raised an order for repair to all defects noted
  - 6.3 Noted that the parish clerk has put up notices about the repair work to Cogden Bridge that is going to be happening to warn residents of potential diversions
  - 6.4 It was brought to attention of the clerk that the drain on Stelling Road needs unblocking so the clerk
  - 6.5 Also brought up that the ditch outside the Green Dragon is still blocked and water is now washing the road out
7. Financial Officers/Clerk's Report: Bank balances for the community account are currently at £5047.34; as the precept was received at the end of April. Authorisation was requested to pay Marrick Institute for storage of the Parish Filing Cabinet and it was also voted that Parish Council would pay the Institute a fee of £100 to hire the hall for the rest of the year for meetings. Would also like to thank Valeria Bradford for completing the internal audit which has now all been signed off and approved for the year. Still continuing to see disruption due to Covid-19 and it does not look like we are anywhere near returning to normal yet.

8. Received Report from Marrick Institute: Insititue has been closed since the end of March due to the restrictions of the coronavirus pandemic and since restrictions are still in place it will remain closed. Inspections of the institute have been on going to keep it maintained and a risk assessment has been done to prepare for the risks of covid 19 with measures put in place to facilitate the new requirements.
